

Luke 5V1-11 THE FISHERMEN

Encounters with Christ

When people meet Jesus...

... they are changed by Jesus!

Setting the scene...

V1: One day as Jesus was standing by the Lake of Gennesaret, the people were **crowding round him** and listening to the word of God.

1) The Command (v4-7)

V4: When he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, 'Put out into deep water, and let down the nets for a catch.'

1) The Command (v4-7)

V6-7: When they had done so, they caught such a large number of fish that their nets began to break. ⁷ So they signalled to their partners in the other boat to come and help them, and they came and filled both boats so full that they began to sink.

2) The Conviction (v8-9)

V8: When Simon Peter saw this, he fell at Jesus' knees and said, 'Go away from me, Lord; I am a sinful man!'

V10: Then Jesus said to Simon, 'Don't be afraid; from now on you will fish for people.'
