

Luke 7v36-50 THE SINFUL WOMAN

Encounters with Christ

When people meet Jesus...

... they are changed by Jesus!

"Conversion is not merely crossing a boundary but submitting to a new reality, orbiting a new sun"

The Setting

V36-37: When one of the Pharisees invited Jesus to have dinner with him, he went to the **Pharisee's house** and reclined at the table.

³⁷ A <u>woman</u> in that town who lived a <u>sinful</u> <u>life</u> learned that Jesus was eating at the Pharisee's house, so she came there with an alabaster jar of perfume.

1) Woman's Action – Devotion

V38: As she stood behind him at his feet weeping, she began to wet his feet with her tears. Then she wiped them with her hair, kissed them and poured perfume on them.

2) Simon's Response – Blindness

V39: When the Pharisee who had invited him saw this, he said to himself, 'If this man were a prophet, he would know who is touching him and what kind of woman she is – that she is a sinner.'

2) Simon's Response – Blindness

5v31-32: 'It's not the healthy who need a doctor, but the sick³² I have not come to call the righteous, but sinners to repentance.'

V40: Jesus answered him, 'Simon, I have something to tell you.'

'Tell me, teacher,' he said.

A parable with 3 characters...

- One money Lender
- Two people who fall into debt
 - Big debt
 - Small debt

V42: Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so...

What did he do?

Option A – Tell them to work harder

Option B — Cancel the debt

V42: Neither of them had the money to pay him back, so **he forgave the debts of both**.

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Now which one will love him more?

V47: Therefore, I tell you that her many sins have been forgiven – <u>as her great love</u> <u>has shown</u>.

Col 2v13-14: When you were dead in your sins and in the uncircumcision of your flesh, God made you alive with Christ. He forgave us all our sins, 14 having cancelled the charge of our legal indebtedness, which stood against us and condemned us; he has taken it away, nailing it to the cross.
