2) GET A RIGHT VIEW OF LEADERS (3v21-4v5)

What does a good leader look like according to Paul?

Explore v3 together... what does it actually look like in practice to not worry about what other people think?

Why does Paul talk about his sufferings as an apostle? Discuss the analogy in v9
What will it mean for you to 'imitate' Paul? (v16)
