**V24:** Brothers and sisters, each person, as responsible to God, should remain in the situation they were in when God called them

V26: Because of the present crisis, <u>I think</u> that it is good for a man to remain as he is.

### 2) Keep eternity in view

**V29-31:** What I mean, brothers and sisters, is that the time is short...

...For this world in its present form is passing away.

### 2) Keep eternity in view

Rom 8v28: And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love him, who have been called according to his purpose.

**V28:** But those who marry will face many troubles in this life, and <u>I want to spare</u> you this.

**V32:** I would like you to be **free from** concern. An unmarried man is concerned about the Lord's affairs — how he can please the Lord. 33 But a married man is concerned about the affairs of this world – how he can please his wife – <sup>34</sup> and his interests are divided.
