































Unmoved?

V26: 'So do not be afraid of them, for there is nothing concealed that will not be disclosed, or hidden that will not be made known.

V27: What I tell you in the dark, speak in the daylight; what is whispered in your ear, proclaim from the roofs.

Mt 5v14-16: You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden. 15 Neither do people light a lamp and put it under a bowl. Instead they put it on its stand, and it gives light to everyone in the house. ¹⁶ In the same way, let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven.
