Mark 7v20-23: He went on: 'What comes out of a person is what defiles them. ²¹ For it is **from within**, out of a person's heart, that evil thoughts come sexual immorality, theft, murder, ²² adultery, greed, malice, deceit, lewdness, envy, slander, arrogance and folly. ²³ All these evils come from inside and defile a person.'

1 Peter 2v23-25: When they hurled their insults at him, he did not retaliate; when he suffered, he made no threats. Instead, he entrusted himself to him who judges justly. 24 'He himself' bore our sins' in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; 'by his wounds you have been healed.' 25 For 'you were like sheep going astray,' but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

- 2) Reconciled to God because of Jesus
- 1 Peter 3v18: For Christ also suffered once for sins, the righteous for the unrighteous, to bring you to God.

V23: If you <u>continue in your faith</u>, established and firm, and <u>do not move</u> from the hope held out in the gospel

2 Cor 5v17-21: Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: the old has gone, the new is here! ¹⁸ All this is from God, who reconciled us to himself through Christ and gave us the ministry of reconciliation: 19 that God was reconciling the world to himself in Christ, not counting people's sins against them.

2 Cor 5v17-21: And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. 20 We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us. We implore you on Christ's behalf: be reconciled to God. ²¹ God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.
