#### **GETTING STARTED**

Remind yourself of Luke's purpose in writing (Acts 1v8) – which is important for understanding why God gave the gift of His Spirit to His church!

Why is the setting in v1 significant? Note Pentecost was a big day before Acts 2! (See Lev 23v15-17)

### 1) PRIMARY MIRACLE – PROCLAMATION (v1-13)

Chat about the significance of the reference to **wind** and **fire** in v2-3... What does this point to?

What's the result of this 'coming of God' in v4?

What do we learn about these 'tongues' in the verses that follow (see v6, 8, 11).

Why did God give this particular gift at this particular point in salvation history? Should we expect the same thing to happen today? If not why not?

#### 2) PRIMARY MESSAGE – SALVATION (v14-41)

How does Peter respond to	the question	and the mocker	y in v12-13?
