# 1) Primary Miracle – Proclamation

**V2:** Suddenly a sound like the blowing of a violent wind came from heaven and filled the whole house where they were sitting.



**V3:** They saw what seemed to be tongues of fire that separated and came to rest on each of them.



# 1) Primary Miracle – Proclamation

John 3v8: The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit.”

## 2) Primary Message – Salvation

## 2) Primary Message – Salvation

**V38:** Peter replied, 'Repent and be baptised every one of you, in the name of Jesus Christ for the forgiveness of sins. And you will receive the gift of the Holy Spirit.

## 2) Primary Message – Salvation

**V40-41:** With many other words he warned them; and he pleaded with them, “Save yourselves from this corrupt generation.” <sup>41</sup> Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.
