GETTING STARTED

Remind yourself of what happened on the day of Pentecost (Acts 2v1-41). By way of summary see v4, v12, v14, v22-23, v32-33, v37-38, v41

The results are glorious (v41) and in the next section (v42-47) we get an insight into what these new believers did when they gathered together...

1) THEY DEVOTED THEMSELVES TO GOD'S WORD

Is it fair to equate the 'apostles teaching' with the word of God? See also Acts 2v43 and Ephesians 2v19-20)

What does it look like to be devoted to God's word and what should that lead to?

2) THEY DEVOTED THEMSELVES TO ONE ANOTHER

What did their 'devotion to one another' look like in v44-45?

How does this apply to us today? How willing should we be to give 'it all' away?

3) THEY DEVOTED THEMSELVES TO WORSHIP

What did their corporate gatherings look like?
