

V8: Now Stephen, <u>a man full of God's</u> grace and power, performed great wonders and signs among the people.



Mt 5v17: "Do not think that I have come to abolish the <u>Law</u> or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfil them.



4) The Verdict (7v54-60)

V59-60: While they were stoning him, Stephen prayed, "Lord Jesus, receive my spirit." ⁶⁰ Then he fell on his knees and cried out, "Lord, do not hold this sin against them." <u>When he had said this, he</u> <u>fell asleep</u>.
