
John 19v28-42 – **The Glorious One Dies**

GETTING STARTED

2) A FULFILLED WORD

a) 'I am thirsty'

b) 'Not one of his bones will be broken'

See also Exodus 12v46 / Psalm 34v20

c) 'They will look on the one they have pierced'

See also Zechariah 12v10 / 13v1
