



John 19v28-42

THE GLORIOUS ONE DIES

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1) A Finished Work

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17v4: I have brought you glory on earth by finishing the work you gave me to do.

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*When you look at the cross...
What do you see?*

2) A Fulfilled Word

V28: Later, knowing that everything had now been finished, and so that Scripture would be fulfilled, Jesus said, “I am thirsty.”

2) A Fulfilled Word



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Psalms 69v21: ... they gave me vinegar for my thirst

Jn 4v37: Let anyone who is thirsty come to me and drink.

2) A Fulfilled Word

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- Jesus died as our 'Passover lamb'



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V32-33: The soldiers therefore came and broke the legs of the first man who had been crucified with Jesus, and then those of the other. ³³ But when they came to Jesus and found that he was already dead, they did not break his legs.

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V36: These things happened so that the scripture would be fulfilled: “Not one of his bones will be broken,”

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Exodus 12v46: “It must be eaten inside the house; take none of the meat outside the house. Do not break any of the bones.”

2) A Fulfilled Word



- Jesus died as a 'thirsty sufferer'
- **Jesus died as our 'Passover lamb'**

John 1v29: "Look, the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!"

2) A Fulfilled Word



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- **Jesus died to open up a 'fountain of forgiveness'**

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V37: ...and, as another scripture says, “They will look on the one they have pierced.”

2) A Fulfilled Word



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Zech 12v10: “They will look on me, the one they have pierced, and they will mourn for him as one mourns for an only child...”

2) A Fulfilled Word



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- Jesus died as our ‘Passover lamb’
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Zech 13v1: “On that day a fountain will be opened to the house of David and the inhabitants of Jerusalem, to cleanse them from sin and impurity.”

V35: The man who saw it has given testimony, and his testimony is true. He knows that he tells the truth, and he testifies so that you also may believe.

V38-39: Later, Joseph of Arimathea asked Pilate for the body of Jesus. Now Joseph was a disciple of Jesus, but secretly because he feared the Jewish leaders. With Pilate's permission, he came and took the body away. ³⁹ He was accompanied by Nicodemus, the man who earlier had visited Jesus at night.
