“L _ _ _” (John 1:4, 3:16, 6:35, 10:10 – others?

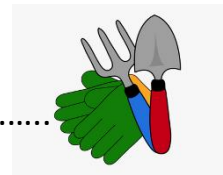
“B _ _ _ _ V E” (John 1:12, 2:11, 3:16, 6:29, 6:47, 20:29, 20:31 and *lots* more)

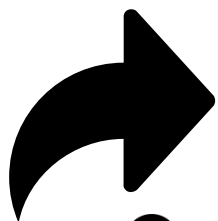
